To be held by SouthPoint Wind regarding a Proposal to Engage in a Renewable Energy Project

Project Name: SouthPoint Wind 1400MW Offshore Wind Energy Project

Project Description:

Pursuant to the Act and Regulation, the facility, in respect of which this project is to be engaged in, is a Class 5 wind Facility. If approved, this facility would have a total maximum name plate capacity of 1400MW. The project location is described in the map below.

The Draft Project Description Report titled "Volume 2.0 Project Description Report(1400MW)" describes the project as thirteen wind farms with a maximum name plate capacity of 1400MW undertaken in two construction phases and located more than 2km from the southern shores of Lake Erie and Lake St. Clair and the municipalities of Leamington, Kingsville, Essex, Amherstburg, Lakeshore and Chatham-Kent in the counties of Essex and Chatham-Kent.
